GUEST INFORMATION & RULES

- The office is generally open from 9am – 4pm daily, if the office is unattended **please call 0426 992 339 for urgent assistance, or to report any noise issues** (we will deal with all noise concerns raised - anonymously and immediately - particularly after 9pm quiet time).
- We are a peaceful bush camp and there is a strict **no noise after 9.00pm** policy – failure to adhere to this may result in being asked to leave. Lights will be automatically turned off at the mill at 9.00pm and the mill, kitchen and table tennis table may not be used after 9pm, as the noise impacts on the guests staying in the dorms. Excessive alcohol consumption (drunkenness) is not permitted.
- Please note: check in time is any time after 2.00pm, please **check out any time before 10.00am**. If you would like to extend your stay, please check availability at the office before 10.00am. If you leave before we open, please drop keys in the key return box (by office).
- Wood fires are permitted in designated fire pits only when fire restrictions permit (**NO FIRES** from late November to Easter). Gas hot plates or BBQ's are not to be used within 10 meters of trees or shrubs – please be EXTREMELY careful as bushfires can be catastrophic. When fires are permitted please BYO Wood or purchase it from the office (please do not collect from the National Park).
- Please be aware that we are inside a National Park and we have very tight restrictions on our water and power usage – **please keep showers to a 4 minute maximum** and minimise use of power (electricity is NOT to be used for heating or cooling) – please note bathroom lights are on a 15 minute timer to conserve energy and avoid attracting insects.
- Black and grey waste water must be collected and disposed of appropriately - there is a new dump point on Walcliffe Rd (next to the Skate Park) – if you do not have facilities in your van to collect your waste water please use the camp kitchen and ablutions.
- Please carefully sort all of your rubbish for recycling at our recycling area and put leftover food scraps in the chook bin in the kitchen.
- Please ensure all food and rubbish is kept in sealed containers and expect wildlife and insects to be regular visitors! Please do not feed or handle the wildlife. Under our lease conditions – no pets are allowed (sorry!) as we are in a National Park.
- If using the kitchen please clean up after yourself immediately – wipe all benches, wash/dry/put away dishes, clean BBQ after use.
- Please stick to paths and roads and do not disturb vegetation, please only erect tents or vans on cleared portion of your site.
- **ALL vehicles entering the facility must register at the office.** All visitors must park at the office (not inside the facility). Visitors are not permitted on site after 5pm. Our facilities (playground, kitchen, bathroom, table tennis, mill etc) are for our overnight guests only.
- Free Wi-Fi at café balcony and limited range elsewhere (not for downloading or streaming video) daily limits apply.



PLEASE do not put cigarette butts on the ground - they harm the environment (littering), harm the wildlife (ingestion) and are a fire risk.
If you leave cigarette butts on the ground or on your site, you will be asked to leave.
